

Without A Sacrifice, There Is No Sanctification

Thesis: The law was a shadow that could not save, but the once-for-all sacrifice of Christ has saved us and set us apart to worship Him.

1. Trusting the shadow won't cleanse us or allow us to draw near to God in worship, but will keep us believing a lie (vs. 1).

2. Trusting the shadow won't bring the Christian the freedom of a clear conscience, but that of a guilty one (vs. 2-4).

3. Trusting the shadow won't accomplish the will of God in salvation, but Christ could accomplish that (vs. 5-7).

4. Trusting the shadow won't fulfill the law, but the once-for-all sacrifice of Christ did (vs. 8-10).

Implications:

1. Trusting in good works to save you will only condemn you.
2. Christ did everything that was needed to save us.
3. Because of the work of Christ you can worship God with your life.
