What is a biblical pilgrim? (1 Peter 2:11-12)

They are one who is on a journey through a foreign land headed to their home in heaven. A holy people destined for a holy land.

What is biblical hope? (Hebrews 6:11)

A confident expectation in the promises of God concerning things He said will come.

How can sinners like us have confidence in a holy God to work for us and secure a bright future? (Romans 8:1-4)

The grace of God is the foundation of our hope (2 Thes. 2:16); the outlet of that grace is the gospel (Col. 1:23). Today's text brings us to the effects of the gospel on the believer. Those who are in Christ do not face the condemnation of God and now can live as a person who is not condemned.
