The Cost of Discipleship

CrossBridge Church Luke 14:25-33

1. Jesus Tells Us to Love Him More Than Anyone Else – Luke 14:26

"To be my disciple... you must give me preeminence over all other relationships."

Our lives should be so <u>submitted</u> to Christ that when you put your <u>allegiance</u> to him side-by-side with other allegiances... the difference is so <u>great</u> that it could be <u>described</u> in the black and white terminology of <u>love</u> and <u>hate</u>.

2. Jesus Tells Us to <u>Bear</u> Our Own <u>Cross for Him</u> – Luke 14:27

<u>Bearing</u> our cross for Jesus means to <u>follow</u> Him and being willing to die to self. In other words... it means <u>total</u> and <u>absolute</u> surrender.

'T'm afraid many people want to <u>negotiate</u> the <u>cost</u> rather than count it. That is, they are willing to give up things but they won't give up the <u>right</u> to <u>determine</u> what those things are." *Tim Keller*

3. Jesus Tells Us to Give Great Care and Thought to Being His Disciple — Luke 14:28-32

Jesus is calling people to <u>follow</u> him in <u>discipleship</u>... and then he's reminding them that it's like building a tower that you don't want to leave half-finished because you don't have enough commitment or enough resources to finish it. (*John Piper*)

"Authentic discipleship may exact from you the highest price relationally and the highest price physically." (*John Piper*)

4. Jesus Tells Us to <u>Renounce All</u> that <u>We Have for Him</u> – Luke 14:33

To be a disciple of Jesus Christ is to <u>deliberately resolve</u> to <u>leave</u> all things... to <u>suffer</u> all things that may be laid on us... and to <u>persevere</u> to the end of our days in the service of Christ.

If you are not <u>willing</u> to do this... the Bible says you <u>cannot</u> be His disciples.
